### Community Chorus at South Berwick

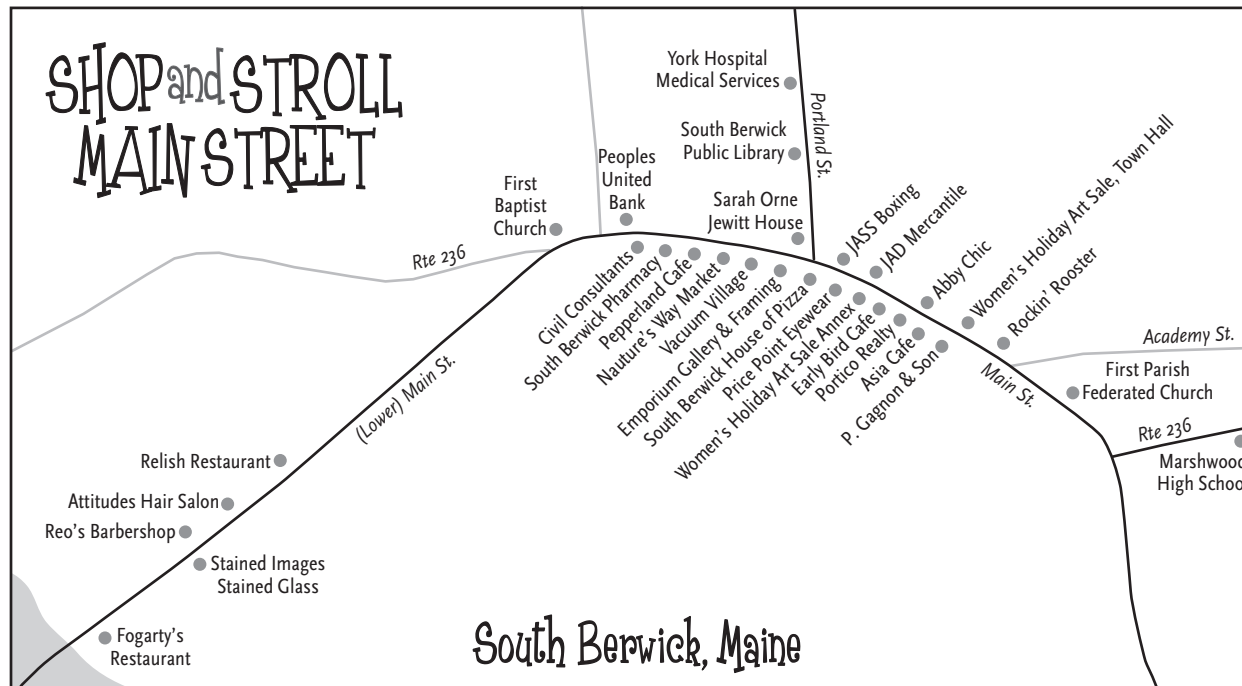
